Biography

Linda Cardillo is the award-winning author of the critically acclaimed novels *Dancing on Sunday Afternoons* and *Across the Table*. After graduating from Tufts University with a degree in American literature, she worked as an editor of college textbooks and then earned an MBA at Harvard Business School at a time when only 15% of the class were women. Armed with her Harvard degree, she managed the circulation of a magazine during its successful start-up, founded a catering business, and then built a career as the author of several works of nonfiction, from articles in *The New York Times* to books on marketing and corporate policy. She later went on to teach creative writing before her debut novel, *Dancing on Sunday Afternoons*, launched Harlequin's Everlasting Love series. She is currently working on her seventh book, the first in a trilogy set in 16th century Italy.
